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PILGRIMAGE ITINERARY:

JULY 31: USA-PORTUGAL:

Overnight transatlantic flight to *Porto*. Dinner and breakfast are served on board.

AUG-1: PORTO-BRAGA:

Upon arrival in *Porto*, your escort will greet you and welcome you to Portugal. You will have a panoramic tour of the *City of Porto*. One of the most important stop, is the *Cathedral of Porto*, one of the oldest and most important Romanesque monuments of Portugal, built between the 12th and the 13th century. Its in this wonder that we will have our first (Mass) as a group. Late afternoon drive to the city of Braga. Dinner and overnight in Braga.

AUG-2:BRAGA-SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA:

This morning after breakfast we will visit the sanctuary of *Good Jesus of the Mount*. The stairs of this formidable baroque temple provide an insuperable example of Christian statuary, depicting the Stations of the Cross and the theological virtues. Next stop, will be the *Shrine of Monte Sameiro*, considered Portugal second most important Shrine honoring Mary. Here she is honored under her title of the *Immaculate Conception*. Its in this Shrine that we will have (Mass). After lunch we will proceed to *Santiago de Compostela* for dinner and overnight.

AUG-3: SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA:

Today we will visit the *Shrine of St. James*. According to legend, the bones of the *Apostle St. James the Great* (Santiago), brother of the Evangelist John and one of Christ's twelve apostles, were transported to Spain after his martyrdom in A.D. 44 and placed at the site of the Cathedral in the year 813. Celebrate (Mass) in the Cathedral. After lunch you will have free time to explore the city on your own. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

AUG-4: SANTIAGO -COIMBRA-FATIMA:

Early morning departure for the town of *Coimbra* for a visit to the *Carmelite Convent*, where *Sister Lucia* lived and died. Sister Lucia was the oldest of the three children of Fatima that witnessed the apparitions of Our Lady. We will have (Mass) in the convent chapel and visit the Museum dedicated to the life of Sister Lucia. We will also stop at *Santa Clara a Nova*, the church that contains the tomb of *Queen Saint Isabella*, the patron Saint of this beautiful city. Late afternoon arrival in *Fatima* for dinner and overnight. (Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

AUG-5: FATIMA:

After breakfast, we will follow the *Hungarian Stations of the Cross*, culminating in the Chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fatima, (Mass) at Calvary Chapel. We will also visit the *Valinhos*, the site of Our Lady's appearance after the children's return from prison and the Hamlet of *Aljustrel*, where the children lived. For lunch we will stop at the "*Centro Commercial*" and shop at the biggest religious super market in Fatima. Afternoon, tour of the Shrine of Fatima and the *Museum of Fatima*, where you are able to see the crown of Our Lady with the bullet that injured John Paul II.

(Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

AUG-6: FATIMA-ALCOBACA-NAZARE:

Today excursion to the ancient town of *Alcobaca* and its principal attraction, the *Abbey of Santa Maria*. Founded in 1153 to commemorate a victory against the Moors, it was completed in 1223. It is now Portugal's largest church, and one of its outstanding architectural monuments. It was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Inside the church are the elaborate stone carved tombs of Dom Pedro and Donna Ines, who have a tragic story similar to Romeo and Juliet, but more gruesome. After our visit we will proceed to *Nazare* - A lovely fishing village

with a very long beach. The lower part of the town still consists of small lanes with fisherman huts. The district *Sito* lies above with approx. 100 m high cliffs. From there is a fantastic view along the coast. We will also visit the Shrine of *Our Lady of Nazareth* and (Mass) at main altar. Late afternoon return to Fatima. (Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

AUG-7: FATIMA-SANTAREM:

Our day begins with breakfast and a short drive to the town of *Santarem*, one of the oldest cities in the world. We will visit the *Church of St. Stephen*, containing the oldest recorded Eucharistic miracle in the world. Venerate the relic of the *Bleeding Host*, stolen by a woman in payment to a sorcerer, the host began to emit a brilliant beam of light and then to bleed. We will also visit the *Cathedral of Santarem*, a palatial baroque 17th-century Jesuit seminary, now serving as the town's Cathedral, with gilded carved altars and a painted ceiling. Its here that we will have our (Mass) and also a visit to the adjoining Diocesan Museum.

Return to Fatima and free afternoon.

(Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

AUG-8: FATIMA:

Morning Mass at the apparition chapel and free time for private devotions, last minute shopping or just explore Fatima on your own.

AUG-9: FATIMA-LISBON-NEW YORK:

Early morning departure for the city of Lisbon. After a panoramic city tour, our main focus is on *St. Anthony*. Despite what might be assumed from his name, Saint Anthony of Padua was born and grew up in Lisbon. The location of his birthplace, is in the crypt of the *Church of St. Anthony* (Mass). Afternoon transfer to the airport for our return flight to the USA.
